The Story

- The story occurs following the Passover celebration, and the death and resurrection of Jesus
- The two characters of the story are referred to as followers of Jesus
- They are depressed to the point of despair
- Jesus appears on the scene but they do not recognize Him



The Story

- Jesus rebukes them for their foolishness and being slow of heart regarding all the prophets had said
- After Jesus has left they comment to each other how their hearts had been warmed as Jesus taught the scripture to them



Deeply Troubled Hearts

- These two people have deeply troubled hearts because things had not gone the way they thought they should
- All hope was lost and nothing was going to change their mind



Encouraged to Tell Our Stories

- Jesus encourages the two to tell their story
- Often it is in the telling of our stories that Jesus reveals Himself to us



Jesus Is With Us

- Jesus is often present in our midst even if we do not recognize His presence



Heading in the Wrong Direction

- We are sometimes heading in the wrong direction
- When we run into struggles and problems we sometimes do not want others to really know how we feel



Only Jesus Can Warm Our Hearts

- God is in the business of warming our hearts if we take the time to allow Him to do it



We've Got a Story to Tell

- When Jesus touches our hearts then we have a story to tell
